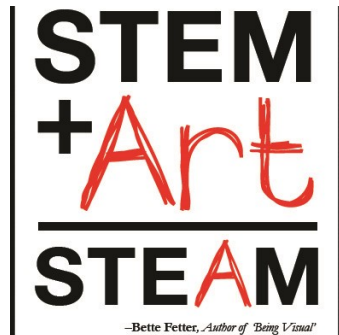


Young Rembrandts, ART and STEM
